This Cookie Policy explains how the Templier Studio website (hereinafter referred to as “the Site”) uses cookies and similar technologies.

This policy complies with:

the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

the ePrivacy Directive

CNIL recommendations

the French Postal and Electronic Communications Code

1. What is a cookie

A cookie is a small text file stored on the user’s device (computer, smartphone or tablet) when visiting a website.

Cookies may be used to:

store user preferences

secure browsing

measure website traffic

personalize the user experience

improve website performance

2. Cookies used on the website

The Site may use several categories of cookies.

2.1 Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for the proper functioning of the website and cannot be disabled.

They allow the website to:

display pages correctly

secure the connection

remember essential preferences (language, cookie consent)

ensure server availability

Examples include:

session cookies
load balancing cookies
security cookies

2.2 Analytics cookies

These cookies are used to analyze website traffic and usage.

Examples include:

Google Analytics
Matomo Analytics
internal performance analysis tools

These cookies are only activated after the user gives consent.

2.3 Functionality cookies

These cookies help improve the browsing experience by:

remembering user preferences
personalizing the navigation experience
saving non-essential settings

These cookies also require user consent.

2.4 Third-party cookies

Some external services integrated into the website may place their own cookies.

Examples include:

Google reCAPTCHA for spam protection
Google Fonts
external CDNs
embedded videos such as YouTube or Vimeo
social media buttons

These services may place cookies after the user has given consent.

3. User consent

When visiting the Site for the first time, the user will see a cookie banner.

This banner allows the user to:

accept all cookies
reject non-essential cookies
customize cookie preferences

User consent must be:

freely given

informed

revocable at any time

The Site does not place non-essential cookies before consent is given.

4. Cookie retention period

According to CNIL recommendations:

necessary cookies are stored only during the browsing session

analytics and functionality cookies are stored for a maximum of 13 months

cookie consent records are stored for up to 6 months

After this period, the user will be asked for consent again.

5. Managing cookies

Users can change their cookie preferences at any time.

This can be done:

through the cookie banner or cookie management module on the Site

through browser settings

Examples include:

Chrome: Settings > Privacy > Cookies

Firefox: Options > Privacy > Cookies

Safari: Preferences > Privacy

Edge: Settings > Cookies and site data

6. Third-party services that may set cookies

Some external services used on the Site may set cookies.

Google Analytics for traffic analysis

Google reCAPTCHA for form protection

hosting services or CDNs to ensure website availability

embedded videos such as YouTube or Vimeo

These services have their own privacy policies.

7. Personal data and cookies

Some cookies may involve the processing of personal data.

These processes are carried out in accordance with the Templier Studio Privacy Policy.
